MINI Camp PACKING LIST

Instruments

Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone Trumpet, Trombone - Bring your personal instrument. Be sure that you are okay bringing your instrument outside. If you have MS rented instruments, please discuss with Mrs. Cyr or Mrs. Gonzalez for permission for outside use.

Double Reed, French Horn, Euphonium, Tuba - We will provide an instrument and reed for you to use for the duration of camp. Most Double Reeds play alto or tenor saxophone (we provide a mouthpiece for tenor), French Horns will play a mellophone, and Tubas will play the Sousaphone. Brass players should bring their own mouthpieces.

Percussion - Students should bring their own sticks and mallets.

Other Items

Clothing- During practices, students should wear a white t- shirt, black shorts and athletic shoes (no crocs, sandals, etc.).

Miscellaneous- Bring Show Music (received at MS), Flip Folder and Lyre (@ High School Music/Hiljee), Water Bottle, Pencil, Tuner (phone tuner is acceptable), Lawn Chairs for Spectators at Concert
